### FY 2020-2021 Budget (This item was discussed later in the meeting after Ms. Soublet arrived)

- Ms. Sylvia Soublet: No actual updates at this time. Mention of budget strains within the County and uncertainty of the budget landscape. Does not know if there will be a budget for any Commission. As soon as Ms. Soublet has more information she will let us know.
  - Commissioner Dwin asked if we should spend any money. Ms. Soublet does not know for certain however it may be most prudent to freeze.
  - Commission inquired about the total budget for Commissions. Ms. Soublet stated it was a pool of \$25,000 and that it was based on project based funding.
  - Commissioner Walker asked to clarify what fiscal year. Ms. Soublet responded current 20-21. Commissioner Walker followed up to request the amount of funds lost by the County. Ms. Soublet responded that the Commissions are funded out of the General Fund and that we serve at the pleasure of the Supervisors. Discretionary funding. Social Services Agency.
  - Commissioner Walker asked about the anticipated impact and if individuals can donate to the Commission. Ms. Soublet- Potentially. Commission on the Status of Women asked the same question.
    - Can discuss more strategies off line
  - Commissioner Thomas inquired about the difference between fundraisers and sponsors. Ms. Soublet – No comment
  - General Discussion regarding the Commission on the Status of Women becoming its own 501(c)3 or sponsored by 501(c)3
  - Commissioner Borjon asked if Supervisor's discretionary budgets could be used to fund? Ms. Soublet- Yes, however it can get complicated
  - Newly elected Chair Johnson stated that she looked forward to discussing future options.
  - Should 21/22 budget still be submitted. Ms. Soublet reiterated that funding is project based.
