Bulletin Title: Alameda County Heat Advisory

Subtitle: Friday, July 21, 2023, through Saturday, July 22, 2023



The National Weather Service (NWS) has issued a Heat Advisory for the eastern areas of **Alameda County** from Friday, July 21, 11am through Saturday, July 22, 11pm. High temperatures are expected to reach the upper 90's to 107 degrees Fahrenheit. A heat advisory is issued when the NWS predicts the heat index is expected to reach 107 degrees Fahrenheit during the day and/or nighttime low temperature will be at least 75 degrees Fahrenheit or higher for at least 24hrs. The heat index is a measurement that considers both the temperature and the humidity, which can make it feel even hotter than it is.

SAFETY TIPS

- Never leave children, or pets unattended in vehicles.
- Limit outdoor activity during the afternoon and evening.
- Use sunscreen if you plan to do outdoor activities.
- Stay hydrated and take cooling breaks.
