Ways to Get Involved:

- **Volunteer:** Assist with disaster response and support community preparedness and recovery efforts.
- **Join CERT:** Enroll in a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program to gain skills in fire safety, search and rescue, team organization, and medical operations.
- **Support at Work:** Contact your Site Safety Team to help with emergency response activities and enhance preparedness at your workplace.
